ORDINANCE 1624

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A TAX RATE FOR INDEBTEDNESS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Greenville and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

ARTICLE ONE: There shall be an annual tax levied on real estate property within the Town of Greenville, for the purpose of paying interest and principal on any indebtedness incurred pursuant to Act of July 12, 1972 (P.L. 781 No. 165) known as Local Government Unit Debt Act or any prior or subsequent act governing the incurrence of indebtedness by the Town.

ARTICLE TWO: This tax shall be levied on the dollar on the valuation assessed for the Town purposes as now is or may be provided by law.

ARTICLE THREE: The rate of tax for the year 2023 shall be ten. five eight (10.58) mills.

ARTICLE FOUR: This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
