

ORDINANCE NO. 1631

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, CHAPTER 523, THEREOF ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”, BY DELETING AND REPEALING §523-16 (A) LOUISA AVENUE SOUTHWARD FROM SHENANGO STREET TO MAIN STREET AND BY ADDING ALAN AVENUE FROM CHICAGO STREET TO COLLEGE AVENUE

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Greenville, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: The Code of Ordinances of the Town of Greenville is hereby amended by deleting and repealing Chapter 523-16 “One-way streets” of ARTICLE II, Traffic Regulations, Section A, by deleting Louisa Avenue Southward from Shenango Street to Main Street.

SECTION 2: The Code of Ordinances of the Town of Greenville is hereby amended by adding Chapter 523-16 “One-way streets” of ARTICLE II, Traffic Regulations, Section A, by adding Alan Avenue Eastward from Chicago Street to College Avenue

SECTION 3: All other provisions of the said Code of Ordinances of the Town of Greenville, not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.
